2 Craft activity

Crafts vary to match the age, ability and topic focus of the group – from Peg Ponies, suitable for Nursery, to Card Craft aimed at older children.

4 Demonstrations - *Can be requested as part of your visit and carry an additional charge.

A. Basic Pony Care – A demonstration by Welfare Assistants of some basic equine care. The use of different grooming brushes is explained, as well as the importance of caring for the animals' feet. There will be an opportunity for some children to participate in the grooming. *Approx 30 mins.*

B. Riding/Carriage Driving Demonstration - Following their initial care and assessment at Bransby Horses, animals that can be rehomed receive training to match their potential; as ridden, driven or companion animals. It is possible to watch a horse being exercised in the outdoor schooling area. Please be aware that this is dependent on the weather, as well as the needs of the horses and staff availability. *Approx 20 – 30mins.*
