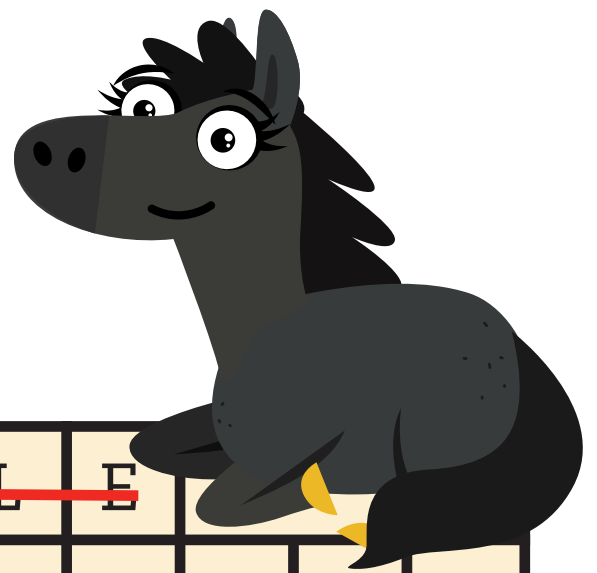
Can you imagine how Pudding was feeling before she was rescued? Take a look at the 'Five Freedoms' to help.

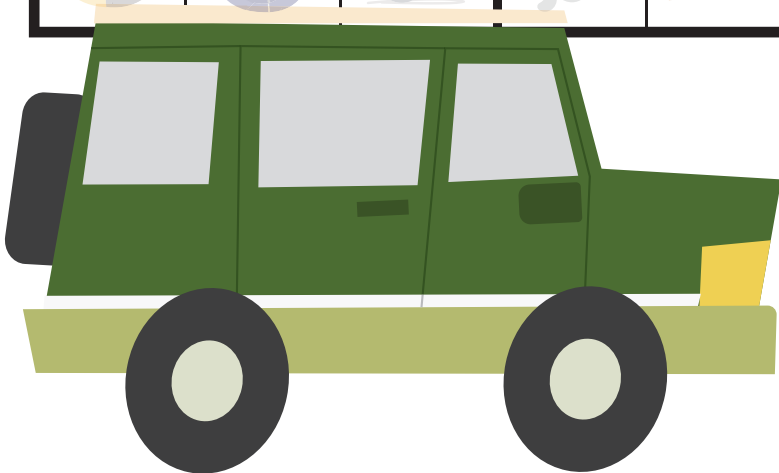
